Petroineos Grangemouth

Note by the Clerk

Background

- 1. On 22 November, it was announced that the oil refinery at Grangemouth would transition to a fuels import terminal. The refinery is owned by Petroineos, a refining and energy trading joint venture, between PetroChina International London and the INEOS Group.
- 2. Earlier this year the Committee held an inquiry into a just transition for the Grangemouth area. The <u>report was published on 21 June 2023</u>.
- 3. While INEOS did not formally engage with the inquiry, it fed into the <u>written submission</u> from Forth Ports Limited and the Forth Green Freeport, as well as <u>oral evidence</u> provided by Forth Ports Limited. It also hosted a visit to the site by the Committee on 20 March 2023.
- 4. Following the November announcement, the Committee took oral evidence on Wednesday 13 December from Petroineos Manufacturing Scotland Ltd, INEOS Grangemouth, and the Cabinet Secretary for Wellbeing Economy, Fair Work and Energy.
