## New Deal for Business – Note by the Clerk

## Background

- 1. The Scottish Government announced the <u>New Deal for Business</u> in April 2023 to "help business and trade to thrive and maximise the opportunity of the green economy, with fairness at its heart".
- 2. A <u>New Deal for Business Group (NDBG)</u> was established by the Scottish Government as a forum for government and business leaders to explore how best to support businesses and communities to work together, as part of the wider delivery of the <u>National Strategy for Economic Transformation</u>.
- 3. In October 2023, the NDBG published an <u>implementation plan</u> to deliver its recommendations, setting out key actions and measurements of success.
- 4. The Committee is holding three evidence sessions to consider the New Deal for Business and progress against the implementation plan.
